

How to Bid / Buy Art in the NDK Art Show

Bidding in the Art Show is a lot like bidding on E-bay. Here's a few tips:

- 1. Find a piece of artwork you would like to buy. There's lots of cool stuff! Feel free to bid on multiple items.
- 2. Obtain a permanent writing instrument. Bids written in pencil, blood, spit, or other non-permanent materials are not accepted. Yes, even if you really, really want it.
- 3. Find the art work's bid sheet next to the art work. It looks like this:

Here you have several choices:

- **Buy the piece for the Quick Sale Price**. This is the artist's "Buy It Now" price. As long as there are **no other bids**, you may buy it now and take it with you.
- Write your minimum bid directly on the bid sheet. Minimum bid must be at least the artist's Minimum Bid Price. Whole dollar amounts only!

Note: Once you have placed a bid on a piece, **you are making a commitment to buy**. Only rare circumstances may you retract your bid with Staff's permission. You cannot cross out or void your bid. Doing so may restrict future purchases.

You are the highest bidder on a piece of art work when:

- I. You paid the Quick Bid price.
- II. You have the highest bid $(1-2 \text{ bids}, \text{ only}^*)$ on the sheet when bidding ends on Sunday (check schedule for time and location).
- III. You win the piece during the Live Auction (check schedule for time and location).
- ★ If a piece receives <u>3 bids</u> or is marked with a red "A" it automatically goes to the Live Auction.

 Be there to join the excitement and defend your bid!
